INFORMATIONAL ITEMS

Kirkwood Report

Justin Hoehn, Associate Director of Marketing, provided the Eagle Update and Kirkwood report, which included:

- On November 6, the Kirkwood Volleyball team defeated the East Central College Falcons by a score of 3-1 to earn a berth in the NJCAA Division II National Tournament. The national tournament will be held at the Alliant Energy Powerhouse in Cedar Rapids November 18-20, 2021.
- In late October, Kirkwood was recognized by the U.S. Department of State's Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs as a top-20 producer of the Benjamin A. Gilman International Scholarship Program since the program's inception two decades ago.
- Student of the Month: Charlotte Greve [Gray-Vah]. Charlotte is from Germany and part of the CBYX exchange program.
- A tool that international students can use to come study at Kirkwood is through a fairly new scholarship program called the #youarewelcomehere scholarship. This program is a welcome message delivered online and through social media to international students around the world. The effort has continued to grow and is now headed up by NAFSA, also known as the Association of International Educators. As a part of the campaign, a scholarship program was developed in 2019 for students wanting to come to the US to study. This is the first year that Kirkwood has participated in the program and we have two awardees: Phuong Tran [Vietnam] and Eriko Higa [Japan].
- Kirkwood Director of Advancement Jody Donaldson has been named a 2021 Corridor Business Journal Woman of Influence.
- Kirkwood Women's basketball have begun the season ranked 3rd in the nation and have three straight wins to begin the campaign. The Men's basketball team is ranked #1 in the nation and have started 2-0.

• Work Based Learning Ramp Build - Offering work-based learning opportunities has become a higher priority at community colleges because they help students to become career-ready following their educational career. Kirkwood's Industrial Tech department is offering a new course this year consistent with this trend in learning. It's offered in the Construction Management and Architectural Technology programs in Jones Hall as well as at three high school academy sites. The goal is to teach project-based learning in the workplace by developing and implementing projects in cooperation with local businesses, community organizations, or non-profit agencies in the Industrial Technology employment sector.

Treasurer Choate provided a shortened financial report due to the in depth report provided October 28 at the board retreat. Choate walked through the recently published FY22 Budget Book highlighting key areas.

Cash balances as of October 31 were reviewed showing 194 days of cash on hand.
