Program Description

The Diagnostic Assistant program is designed for Radiologic Technology students in partnership with the Mercy/St. Luke's School of Radiologic Technology.

The two-year Radiologic Technology technical program is taught through Mercy/St. Luke's, begins each summer, and has a separate application process.

Students must complete prerequisite courses at Kirkwood in order to enter the Mercy/St. Luke's School of Radiologic Technology program. After they complete the program and receive their certificate in Radiologic Technology, students can transfer those credits back to Kirkwood to receive this degree, as long as the prerequisite courses were taken at Kirkwood.

This Allied Health program has a mandatory background check for clinical purposes.

Upon completion of the degree, a graduate will be able to perform various imaging techniques while providing quality patient care.
