Reason for Procedure

The procedure defines a unit of credit and establishes minimum requirement for credit hours awarded by instructional modality.

The Procedure

Kirkwood defines a unit of credit as a semester hour. A semester hour of credit is given for one hour in class each week for a period of 16 weeks. (See *College Catalog*) No registration or orientation hours may be included when determining credit hours. The College's minimum requirements are:
